Forest Hills resident Walter Paul Bebirian, a world-renowned photographer/artist, recently had his work exhibited at the "Harvest of Artists" exhibit of painting, photography, multimedia, printmaking, sculpture, and more at the BJ Spoke Gallery (299 Main Street in Huntington), a Best Gallery on Long Island nominee.
